When snow would blow in from the open side, he would just pull the covers over his head and curl up with his cat, which slept in the bed also to keep him warm.

As a boy, he also had a dog, named Rover, that would pull him to school in the winter on a sleigh or in a wagon in good weather.

In 1923, Richard went back to Germany on a mission for the LDS Church. It was there that he met Frieda Boldt. In 1927 Frieda was able to im-

He attributes his good health and long life to following the word of wisdom, especially not smoking. He continually tries to help others quit smoking.

He has also served as High Councilor, Sunday School President, counselor in the Bishopric; he is still serving as a home teacher at the age of almost 98.

Patriarchal Blessing - Mar. 25, 1918

March 25, 1918.

A blessing given by Abundio Olsen, Patriarch,  
upon the head of Richard Emil Bekking, born  
April 16<sup>th</sup> 1902, in Cammin, Germany.

Brother Richard, through the grace of God,  
and in authority of the holy priesthood do I place  
my hands upon thy head, and bless thee in the name

of Jesus Christ, into whom thou hast believed for  
redemption from death and the grave. He is the  
life and author of salvation; He needs be thine  
ideal. I bid thee, thou favored son, to begin even  
now, to read his beautiful life and mission as  
contained in the four gospels; Matthew, Mark, Luke,  
and John; yes I bid thee read on and finish the  
new testament. I promise thee tho thy year are tardy,  
thy bosom shall heave with with fond remembrance.  
Thy spirit be enlarged, thy capacity for knowledge  
be increased. Ah that you may hunger and  
thirst after righteousness, that you may escape the  
pitfalls of youth, the snares of early manhood,  
that you steer clear of the quicksands of youth,  
for many of the promising sons of God have  
been blighted at the score, and have never  
attempted the race for eternal life. Hence, I  
bid thee, be not deceived, entrench thyself against  
the evils of the hour, for thy generation is surrounded

with the wicked propensities, and the power of darkness  
is lurking to destroy the sons of men. Oh listen Richard  
to the pleadings of those who love thee; Honor thy  
father, and thy mother, who conceived and loved
