



Rasmus Orlando was the second child and first son of nine children. Rasmus Orlando was born Mar 11, 1866. This was one year after the Black Hawk Indian War broke out in San Pete County in 1865. In 1866 Rasmus Orlando's Grandmother Karen Caroline passed away while the family lived at Fort Ephraim. They moved back to Spring City just before Rasmus Orlando was born. His father Rasmus Larsen was a captain fighting to protect the settlers from the Indians. When Rasmus Orlando was only two his Grandfather, Lars Alexander Justesen was shot and killed in an Indian attack. Rasmus, his 6 brothers, and 2 sisters grew up in this home on Main Street in Spring City Utah.
